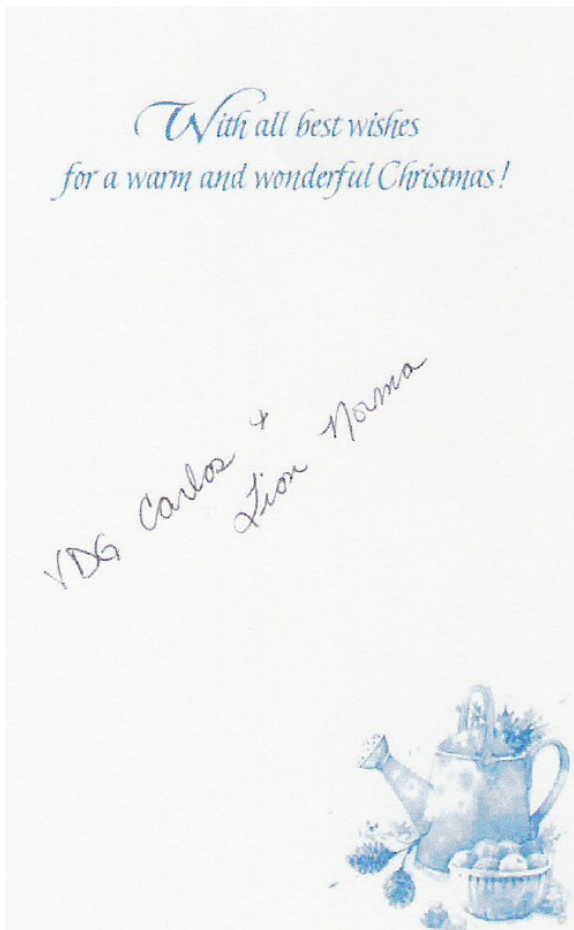

Indiana Distinguished Lion Award 2006

The Indiana Lions Foundation, Inc. is again sponsoring the Indiana Distinguished Lion Award to recognize an outstanding member of the Lions of Indiana. This award will be presented at the 2006 State Convention Saturday morning breakfast. The award is a standing lion replica for the recipient's desk and their name placed on a plaque in the Lions State Office.

The qualifications for this prestigious award include that the nominee must be a member of a Lions Club in Multiple District 25 (Indiana) and has been a Lion in good standing for at least 25 years prior to the nomination. Nominations may be presented by a Lions Club, the sub-district cabinet with approval by the sitting District Governor, or by the Council of Governors with the approval of the Council Chair.

Nomination forms are available from any trustee of the Indiana Lions Foundation (see your district of state directory), or from the Indiana Lions State Office website (www.indianalions.org).

Please note that nomination must be on the Nomination Form or may be word processed or hand written. But in any event, must provide details of the nominee's service in the order as listed on the official application form. Any other supporting details should be listed at the end or on a separate page.

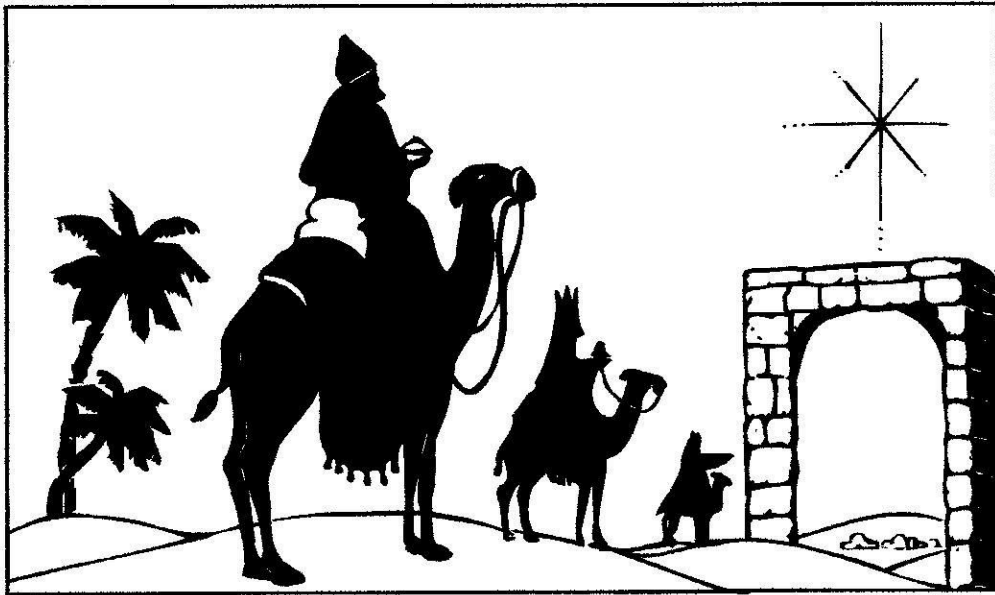

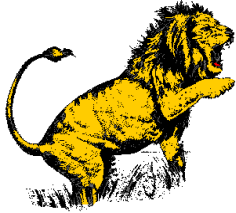

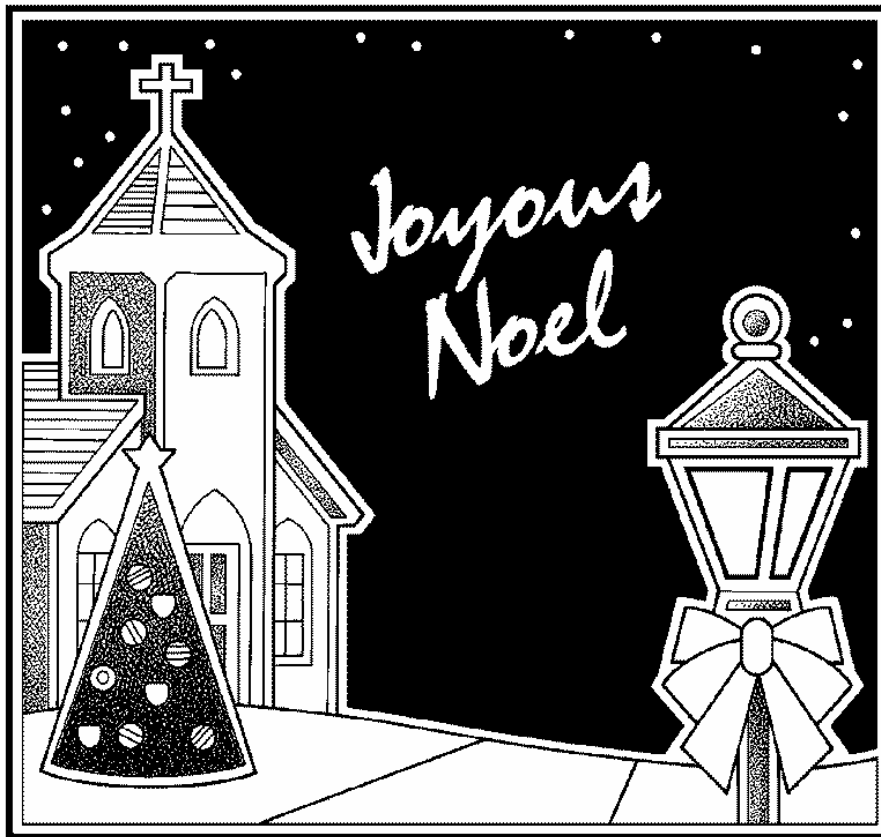
